## **CASE OF INTEREST**

### **Sex Offender Sentenced to Life for Child Sexual Assaults**

**CASE:** Glen Dale Lemons

The Honorable Matthew Gary sentenced Glen Dale Lemons to 185 years to life in prison. On April 26, 2016, a jury convicted Lemons of nine counts of committing lewd acts with a child under 14 years of age. The molestations occurred in Sacramento, Placer and Sutter County.

From 2000 to 2014, Lemons molested two female family members and two extended female family members when they were 4 to 11 years old. He would touch the girls when their parents were not in the same room and when the girls were asleep. Lemons has a history dating back to 1991 of exposing himself in front of young girls, soliciting a minor to commit sex acts and possessing child pornography. He has been to prison five times since 1990 and has been a sex offender registrant since 1994.
