Proposed Placement of Sexually Violent Predator

The Department of State Hospitals has petitioned the Humboldt County Superior Court to place a Sexually Violent Predator at 9675 Harvey Road in unincorporated Sacramento County CA 95632.

The Sacramento County Sheriff's Office, pursuant to Welfare and Institution Code 6609.2 and 6609.1, is notifying affected community members of the proposed placement and providing the following information for the community to submit written comments in opposition of proposed placement to the Humboldt County Superior Court. The Sacramento Sheriff's Office and the Sacramento District Attorney's Office are not responsible for the selection of the proposed site. The selection process is the sole responsibility of the Department of State Hospitals and/or their designee.

- Community comments must be received prior to **January 25, 2021** to ensure timely submission to the Humboldt County Superior Court.
- Written comments should include factual information and SHALL not include threatening, intimidating, or harassing language. Comments that contains language that could be construed as demeaning or inappropriate to the court will not be submitted.

Pursuant to the ongoing public health crisis interested parties are encouraged to appear via zoom. Humboldt County Superior Court is currently not open to the public. The courtroom's Video link or call in information can be located at:
