Thank you for the opportunity to address the Board regarding the administrative review of inmate Allen Noble CDCR- AC05586, and his suitability for early release.. I also do not want to fail to mention Mr. Noble's numerous other identifiers which are CDC-AU09009, CDC-V006749 [REDACTED].

A review of Mr. Noble's criminal history shows a constant disregard for the law [REDACTED]. Interspersed in his multiple prison commitments are a plethora of parole violations.

Mr. Noble's criminal history sheds light on his danger to the community. In 1998 Noble was arrested for attempted murder. That attempted murder case resolved for a California Youth Authority commitment and a strike offense. While incarcerated, Noble committed an assault on a non-inmate and was sentenced to an additional 2 years in prison. Paroled in 2005 Noble promptly violated parole. In 2005 Noble was arrested for being a felon in possession of a firearm and received another state prison sentence. Released from the fresh prison term Noble violated parole in 2008. In 2009 Noble was again arrested for being a felon in possession of a firearm and earned yet another state prison sentence. On 10/23/13 Noble was contacted in the company of another Varrio Franklin Blvd Norteno, Alvino Gastelum X ref 3153525, and both admitted being affiliated with the gang. In the present commitment offense Noble possessed a stolen loaded firearm in a vehicle and stated, "He got the gun from a friend for free and he would only use it for protection."

Given Mr. Noble's voluminous and dangerous criminal history, and his continued disregard for the laws of this State, the Sacramento County District Attorney's Office requests that the Board find the inmate Schaffer is not appropriate for early release at this time.
