

firearms. Yet, when released into our community, he is found to be armed with firearms which is dangerous.

Now he is up for release into our community, but has demonstrated that he has never been meaningfully crime-free. He consistently commits crimes while on probation or parole. He has no regard for the law, the property rights of other people, or the safety of innocent victims. He is unquestionably an unreasonable risk of danger to the community.

As we are given 30 days to respond, and we are not provided with any disciplinary history or any other information aside from the one page notice of parole review, I cannot comment on Inmate Brulez's prison conduct. However, from the record that is available it is clear that Inmate Brulez should not be released as he poses a significant, unreasonable risk of violence to the community. Parole should be denied.
